Guidelines for Grant Applications

The Greygates Foundation supports organizations that serve the needs of children, the elderly, the disabled, or the disadvantaged, and to organizations that promote animal welfare or wildlife preservation. The Foundation makes grants to organizations that are recognized as registered charities by the Canada Revenue Agency, to support projects worldwide. The Foundation makes grants for general operating support, capacity building, program support, equipment, and tuition assistance. **The grant award limit is \$3,000.** Grants are paid in Canadian dollars. Organizations may receive only one grant per calendar year.

The Foundation does not provide funding to individuals, to organizations or programs operated by government agencies, or to organizations receiving significant support (> 50%) from government and or gaming sources (lotteries, casinos, bingo parlors, etc.).

There is no proposal submission deadline, and proposals are accepted on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified promptly when their proposals are received, and should expect to wait three to six months to be notified of a decision.

Proposals must include:

- a description of the organization
- a description of the specific project, if the request is not for general operating support, and the amount requested
- a budget for the proposed project, if the request is not for general operating support
- audited financial statements for the previous fiscal year, if available, or unaudited financial statements if an audit was not performed
- a description of the organization's typical income sources, allocated by percentage (e.g., 40% from foundations, 10% from individuals, 3% from government, etc.)
